Similarly, with only one opponent 3, £ needing to fall for your b luff, bluffing is more likely to be successful.</p&gt; <p&gt;How to play heads-up poker&lt;/p&gt; <p&gt;As mentioned above, the 3, £ rules for many forms of poker don t change when playing heads-up.
